This is more than a prayer guide; it's an invitation. An invitation to get comfortable, make yourself at home (whatever that means to you), rest in God's presence, and commune with Him.

Through the H.O.U.S.E. Prayer Framework, you'll discover a simple yet powerful way to pray: one that brings structure to your time with God and transforms the way you connect with Him, your loved ones, and the world around you.

You don't need fancy words or perfect theology. You just need a willing heart and a few quiet minutes. Let this be your invitation to come home to God's presence.

Why Pray Scripture?



God's Word is not just meant to be read, it's meant to be trusted, believed, and prayed back to Him.

When we pray Scripture, we align our hearts with God's heart. We stop guessing what to say and start agreeing with what He has already said.

Scripture is God-breathed (2 Timothy 3:16) and faithful to accomplish what He promises (Isaiah 55:11). Praying Scripture transforms our prayers from our will to His will and invites His power into every area of life.



It is rooted in truth. God's Word is unchanging and trustworthy. (John 17:17)



It shapes our hearts. It renews our thinking and aligns our desires with His. (Romans 12:2)



It **releases God's promises**. His promises are yes and amen in Christ. (2 Corinthians 1:20)



It **builds our faith**. As we pray His Word, we remember who He is and what He can do. (Romans 10:17)



KEY TAKEAWAY

Praying Scripture helps us pray with confidence, clarity, and faith because we're praying His words, not just ours.

His Word in our hearts becomes His power in our prayers.

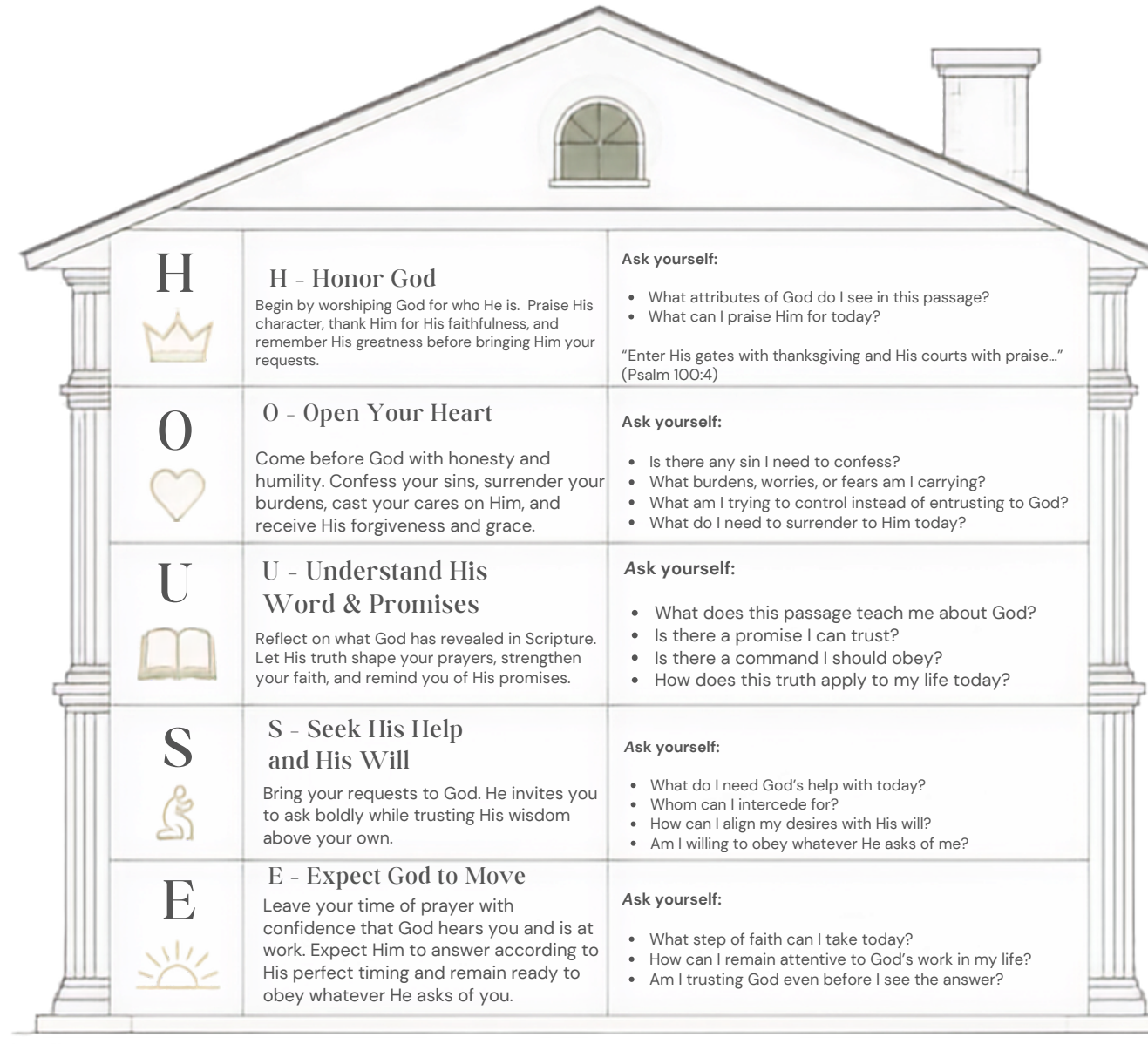

Pray Through a Passage

Choose a passage of Scripture and invite God to speak. Read, reflect, and respond using the H.O.U.S.E. framework. Use this as an example.

SCRIPTURE PASSAGE

Psalm 23 (ESV)

The LORD is my shepherd;
I shall not want.

He makes me lie down in green pastures.
He leads me beside still waters.

He restores my soul.
He leads me in paths of righteousness
for his name's sake.

Even though I walk through the valley of the
shadow of death, I will fear no evil,
for you are with me;
your rod and your staff, they comfort me.

You prepare a table before me
in the presence of my enemies;
you anoint my head with oil;
my cup overflows.

Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me
all the days of my life,
and I shall dwell in the house of the LORD

Before You Begin

Pause. Ask the Holy Spirit to open your heart and help you hear from God through His Word.



HONOR GOD

Who is God?



Lord, You are my Good Shepherd, and I praise You because You faithfully provide everything I need. Thank You for leading me beside still waters, restoring my soul, and guiding me in paths of righteousness for Your name's sake.



OPEN YOUR HEART

Whats going on in my heart?



Father, when I walk through dark valleys, I confess that fear and worry often try to take hold of my heart. Help me to surrender my anxieties to You, trusting that Your presence, Your rod, and Your staff are enough to comfort and sustain me.



UNDERSTAND HIS PROMISES

What has God said?



Lord, thank You for reminding me through Your Word that You are always with me and that I will never lack what I truly need. Strengthen my faith to trust Your promises, even when I cannot yet see where You are leading.



SEEK HIS HELP & HIS WILL

What do I need, and how can I align with God?



Father, today I need Your strength to face the situations before me. Even in the presence of opposition, uncertainty, or hardship, help me rest in the confidence that You are with me, providing for me, and preparing the way ahead. Teach me to trust Your plans more than my own.



EXPECTANT FAITH

How will I trust God moving forward?



Lord, I choose to trust that Your goodness and steadfast love will follow me all the days of my life. Help me to walk forward in faith, expecting You to fulfill Your perfect purposes and rejoicing that my eternal home is with You forever.

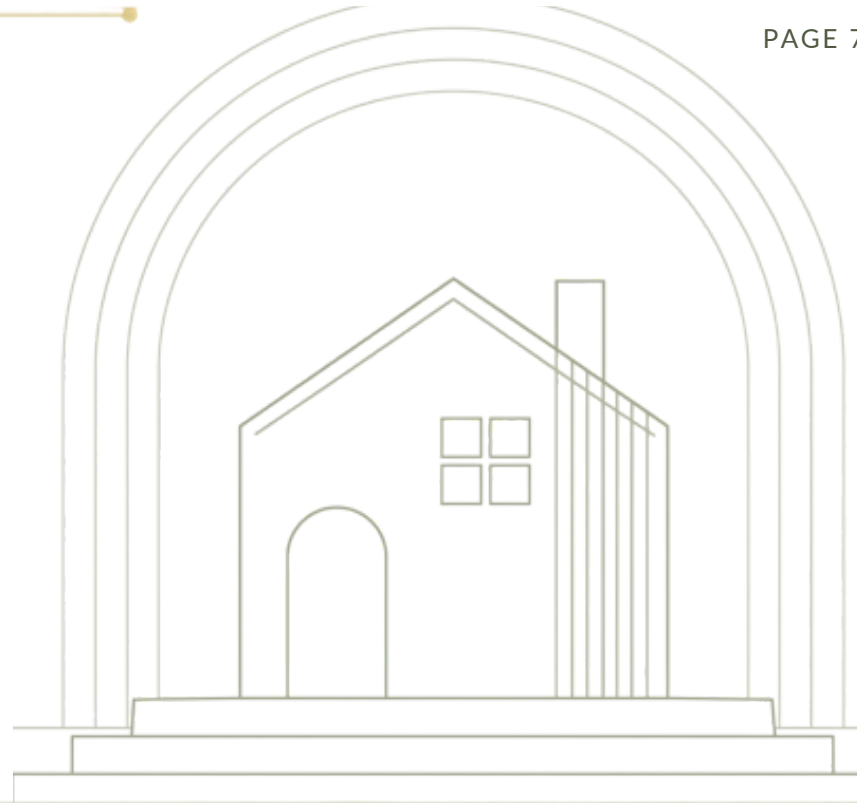


Build the House
